Solar Applied Materials Technology Corp added to the LBMA's Silver Good Delivery List

The LBMA announces that **Solar Applied Materials Technology Corp** ("Solar") has been added to its Good Delivery List for silver, with effect from 12th June, 2008. Solar is the first refiner from Taiwan to be granted Good Delivery status in respect of its silver production, bringing the total number of Chinese and Taiwanese refiners to be accepted onto the LBMA's Good Delivery List for silver to twelve.

Solar has satisfied the LBMA as to its production capability and financial standing. It has also passed the LBMA's exhaustive testing procedures, under which its silver bars were examined and assayed by independent referees, and its own assaying capabilities have been tested.

Solar is based in the Environmental Science Technology Park in Tainan County, Taiwan. The company is one of Taiwan's leading material processing specialists with almost 30 years experience in treating chemical and other waste ranging from electrical scrap to petrochemical catalyst material.

Background

The London Good Delivery List of Acceptable Refiners of gold and silver is maintained by the LBMA, by whom it is copyrighted. It lists those refineries whose gold and silver bars have been found to meet the required standard for acceptability in the London bullion market when originally tested. The List now includes 59 gold and 66 silver refiners.
